Housing Authority to Close Section 8 Program to New Applicants

The Topeka Housing Authority will stop accepting pre-applications for the Section 8 Rental Assistance program as of 4:30 p.m., Tuesday, August 28, 2012. The decision to close the waiting list to new applications is based on the determination that an adequate pool of applicants is available for the expected number of families that can be added to the program in coming months.

Applicants included on the current waiting list are those submitting completed pre-applications prior to 4:31 p.m. August 28, 2012 who qualify for Topeka Housing Authority's admission preference for working families.

The Topeka Housing Authority uses an admission preference for working families living in Topeka. This means rental assistance is first made available to Topeka families whose head of household, spouse or sole member is employed and wages are received on a regular basis. Applicants are given the benefit of the working family preference if the head of household, spouse, or sole member is age 62 or older, or is a person with a disability

If a family wishes to stay in their current rental home or apartment the dwelling must meet housing quality standards, have reasonable rent, and the landlord must be willing to enter into a contract with the Section 8 program.

The Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher program provides assistance with monthly rent costs to low income working families, with funds provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Topeka's Section 8 Housing Choice Rental Assistance Program currently provides help with monthly rental costs to more than 1,200 Topeka families served by more than 400 private sector landlords.
